YCULTURE METRO GRANTS BACK FOR 2010

Propel Youth Arts WA announces the return of grants funding program for young people

YCulture Metro is a funding and development program for youth arts and culture projects based in metropolitan Perth.

The program provides arts grants of **up to \$3000** for young people aged between 12 – 26 years.

First timers are encouraged to apply - specifically those at an entry level in their arts practice with limited experience in grant application writing as well as initiating and coordinating projects.

In 2009 YCulture Metro supported projects ranging from dance, music, literature, circus, visual arts and film.

In 2010 a minimum of ten grants will be on offer, with funding applications open all year round.

“We are delighted to continue YCulture Metro in 2010, to meet the needs of Perth’s dynamic youth arts community,” said Propel General Manager Sonja Basic.
